Students are invited to join our worship team practice and sing on Wednesday nights and at various other events.

Every 3 months, in place of an Oasis, students bring their unsaved friends for an extreme outreach event.

During the summer months, Middle and High School students join for a local mission project followed by a time of fun in the pool (Weekly Active Volunteer Excursion).
